ERNEST FRASER ALLEN, D.D.S.

Born in Walkerville, Ontario, May 14, 1898.

At an early age, he went to New Westminster, B.C., and entered the University of British Columbia later, but transferred to Dentistry in the University of Toronto from which he graduated in 1923. He began practise in Vancouver upon graduation.

While studying dentistry in Toronto, he enlisted with the 5th University P.P.C.L.I. Reinforcements, in November, 1915, and saw service in France. In World War II, he became District Dental Officer of M.D. 11 with the rank of Captain. Became Lt.-Col. in 1941
