Born in the West.

Graduated from the Faculty of Dentistry, University of Toronto in 1925, and after a post-graduate internship in the Toronto Western Hospital, he practised in Toronto.

World War II: Appointed Lieutenant in the Non-Permanent Active Militia in 1933, and was promoted to Captain when he went on active service in 1939. He proceeded overseas with a General Hospital Unit of the First Canadian Division. Following his return to Canada in the summer of 1942, he served in Military District No.2, Toronto until his appointment to his present post (1944) of District Dental Officer, M.D. No.10, Winnipeg. In November 1943, he was promoted to the rank of Lieut.-Col.
