In 1923 he was President of the Academy of Dentistry, and in 1946 President of the University of Toronto Alumni Federation. He is also past President of the Dental Alumni Association and the Ontario Dental Association, as well as being an honorary life member, a member of the Executive Committee and Chairman of the Benevolence Committee of the latter Association. He has also been Secretary of the Toronto Dental Society.

He has served on the staff of the Faculty of Dentistry, University of Toronto, and has been Director of Dental Services at the Hospital for Sick Children.

In World War II he was an honorary Major in the Royal Canadian Dental Corps, as an instructor in the army dental training school.

He is a member of the Masonic Order and of the Knights of the Round Table. He is an Elder in his Church.
