Born in King's County, Nova Scotia.

Educated in the west, and a graduate of the University of Alberta, 1930.

Prior to coming to Ottawa in 1947, he practised dentistry in Barrhead, Alberta, Wetmore, and Edmonton.

In World War I, he saw 38 months of service in France with the Canadian Remounts, Canadian Engineers, and the 14th Battalion.

In World War II, he joined the Canadian Dental Corps, Oct., 1939, at Edmonton. Served for a while as Acting Command Dental Officer of No.40 Coy, C.D.C.(R.C.A.F.). Made a Major in 1943.

In 1948, he was appointed to head the Dental Health Division of the Department of National Health and Welfare.

At one time he was a member of the Alberta Provincial Legislature.
