Graduated in dentistry from McGill University in 1915.

Served four years with the Canadian Army Dental Corps in World War I, and saw service in France and Germany as well as in Canada and in Great Britain. He was appointed to the Canadian Dental Corps at the outbreak of the present war and served three years overseas. In September, 1941, he was promoted to Major, and in June, 1944, was appointed Officer Commanding No. 7 Coy C.D.C. at Debert Military Camp, Nova Scotia, as Lt.-Col.
