Graduated from Dalhousie University in 1923, and practised in Halifax until his transfer to the C.D.C. as O. C. of the District

World War I: Enlisted January, 1916, and went to France with the 3rd Division, Field Artillery where he remained until severely wounded in 1918. He joined the 18th Halifax Coast Brigade in 1922 and served continuously to date (1944).

World War II: was called up for service with the coast Brigade and was O. C. of one of the batteries. His decorations include the D. C. M. and the Victory, Service, Coronation and Efficiency Medals.

He is a member of the Waegwoltic Club, the Red Cap Snow Shoeing Club and the R. N. S. Yacht Squadron.
