

MICHAEL ARMACOST COX. M.B.

Born in Chicago, Illinois in 1893.

Entered University College in 1915 and graduated in 1918.

Is clinical teacher in Paediatrics, and Professor and Head of the Department of Preventive Dentistry at the Dental College.

He is physician in charge of the Out-patients Department at the Hospital for Sick Children, Toronto.

For many years he has been an examiner on the Board of Examiners at the Faculty of Dentistry, University of Toronto, and a member of two committees of council of this faculty: the executive, and and the Dental Service, Hospital for Sick Children, Committee.

Recently he made a tour of all the hospitals in the United States with the Hospital for Sick Children in view. He has also travelled extensively in England and France to learn hospital methods there.

He has been a clinician and essayist at many of the annual Conventions of the Ontario Dental Association.

He represented the Faculty of Dentistry at the "Inservice Training Course" for the evaluation of the dental caries control technics. at the University of Michigan in 1947.

His writings include: "Manifestations of disease in the mouth".
