Graduated from McGill University in 1914.

After two years of practice in Westmount, Quebec, he enlisted in the Canadian Army Dental Corps in October, 1916, and served in England from 1917 to 1918.

He was transferred from the Reserve List of Officers to No.4 Co'y, M. D. No. 4, Montreal, in October, 1939. He was appointed District Dental Officer, M.D. No.4, with the rank of Major, on June 1, 1940. He was promoted to Lieut.-Col. on March 13, 1942.

He was Assistant Superintendent of the Out-Door Clinic of the Montreal General Hospital from 1914-1916, and Demonstrator in Clinical Dentistry in the same clinic from 1926-1939. He was Lecturer in Operative Dentistry at McGill University from 1919-1923.
