

Roy Alexander Gilbert

Born in St. Thomas, Ontario on July 9th, 1895.

Matriculated from St. Thomas Collegiate Institute in 1912, and obtained his Honour Matriculation in 1914; entering R.C.D.S. in 1914.

While a student at the College, he enlisted in the C.A.D.C. and returned to graduate in 1917.

Following the war, he practised in St. Thomas, Ontario.

He took post-graduate work at the University of Michigan and is a member of the Michigan State Dental Society. He is an Honourary member of the 91st Elgin Regiment; 32 A.F. & A.M., Past District Deputy of the Knights of Pythias, and Charter member of the St. Thomas Kiwanis Club.
