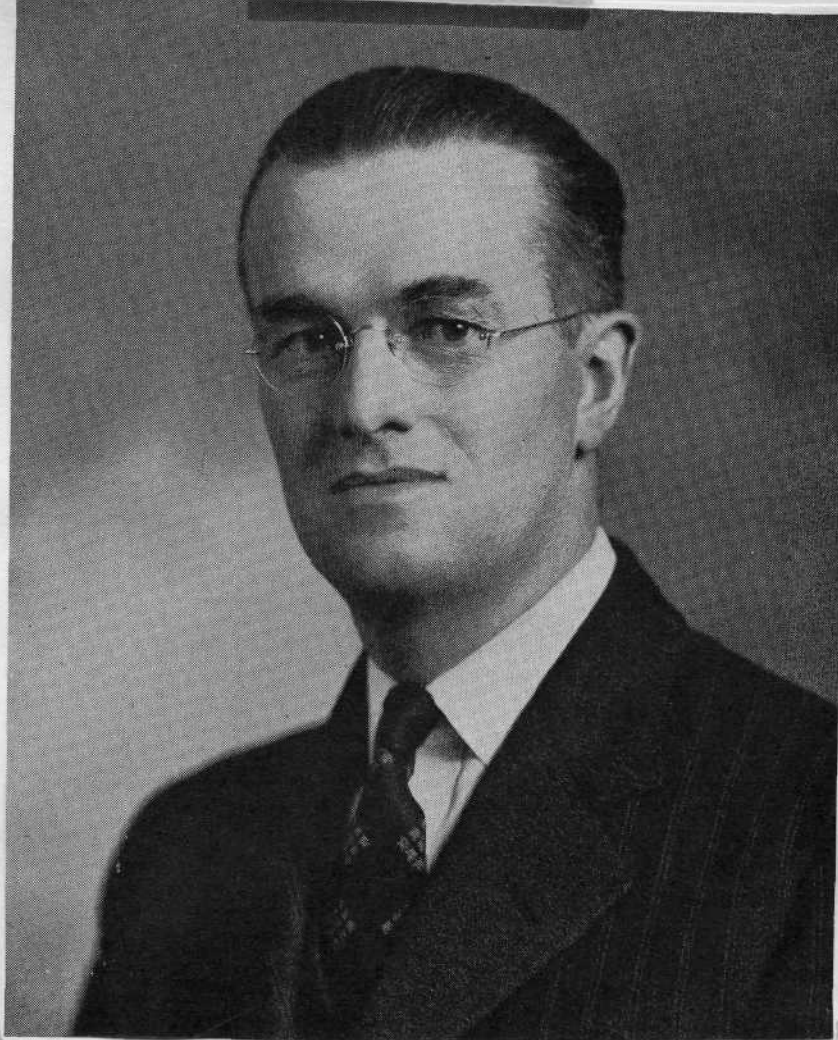


DR. D.W. GULLETT, PICTON, ONTARIO

On May 1 next Dr. D.W. Gullett, of Picton, Ontario, will take over the duties of Secretary to the Board of the Royal College of Dental Surgeons of Ontario.

Following overseas service with the 73rd Artillery Unit of Kingston and the 2nd Canadian Tank Corps in the Great War, Dr. Gullett was graduated from the University of Toronto in 1923, following which he established his practice in Picton. He was a member of the Picton Public School Board for many years and was its chairman for a term. He is a Past Master of Prince Edward Lodge A.F. & A.M., Past President of the Kiwanis Club and Tennyson Club, a member of the Library Board and Hospital Board for several years, a member of the Session of Picton United Church and treasurer of the Church for three years.

  - Graduated from the Royal College of Dental Surgeons, Toronto, in 1923. *practiced at Picton for 17 yrs*
  - Has been District Representative of the Royal College of Dental Surgeons *Chairman of the School Board* since 1936. - *Direct member of the Board, R.C.D.S. in 1936.*
  - Appointed <sup>President</sup> Secretary of the Board of the Royal College of Dental Surgeons in 1940.
  - Secretary of the Canadian Dental Association, 1942 - *a wife has served both organizations*
  - Past President of the Picton Kiwanis Club and the Tennyson Literary Club.
  - Past Master, Prince Edward Lodge, A.F. & A.M.
  - Past First Principal, Prince Edward Chapter, R.A.M.

DONALD WERDEN GULLETT, D.D.S., F.A.C.D.

Born at Wellman's, Ontario, September 18, 1898.

Received his early education at Syracuse, N. Y., and Matriculated from Picton Collegiate. He attended Peterborough Normal School from 1916-1917.

He graduated from the Royal College of Dental Surgeons in 1923, then practised in Picton for 17 years until 1940, where he was Chairman of the Picton School Board, Literary Board and Hospital Board. He was Treasurer of the Picton United Church, and held office in many other local organizations.

He has been District Representative of the Royal College of Dental Surgeons since 1936, and was elected a member of the Board in 1936.

In 1940, he was appointed Registrar-Secretary of the Royal College of Dental Surgeons, a position he has held ever since.

From 1943 until the present time, he has been Secretary of the Canadian Dental Association.

In 1942, he was Ontario Delegate, the Canadian Dental Association.

In 1943, he was made a Fellow of the American College of Dentists.

In 1948, he was made Associate in Dental Praxis at the University of Toronto, Faculty of Dentistry.

He was in Great Britain in July and August of 1948 studying the introduction of the new National Health Act.

The British Dental Association, on June 21, 1949, conferred an Honorary Life membership on him at Scarborough, England.

He is also an Honorary member of the American Dental Association, as well as several other dental organizations.
