World War II: Appointed Adjutant of No. 34 Coy, C.D.C., attached
to No. 3 Training Command, R.C.A.F., in Sept., 1940.
Appointed Junior Dental Officer attached to the 9th
Field Ambulance, R.C.A.M.C. in April, 1938, reported
for duty with the original Active Service Dental Coy
in M.D. No.4 in October, 1939, and was promoted to
Captain in Dec., 1939. In 1942, he was promoted to
Major, and in 1944, to Lt./Col.
