



GORDON KNAPP, D.D.S.

Born at Lion's Head, Bruce County, Ontario, Feb. 24, 1898.

Went to Lion's Head Public School, then to Oakwood Collegiate. While at the latter, he enlisted in the 48th Highlanders when World War I broke out. He saw service in Canada, England, France and Belgium, and returned to Canada in 1919, where he completed his matriculation at the University of Toronto prep course and entered dentistry in 1920, graduating in 1924.

He practised from 1924-1927, at Hensall, Ontario, then moved to Toronto, where he has been ever since.

He was Treasurer, Secretary and President of the Central Toronto Dental Society from 1936-1940.

He has served in a relief capacity in Toronto Schools several times and worked at the Toronto Western Hospital Clinic one morning each week for 12 years or more.

He was made an Elder in the Centennial United Church, 1942, is a member of St. Clair Lodge, A.F. & A.M., Toronto; a director of the Canadian Progress Club, Toronto West, for one year.

In 1948, he was representative of the Toronto Central Dental Society on the University of Toronto Alumni.
