He became Lieut. in the C. B. D. C. in <sup>Oct.</sup> 1939, in April 1940 he  
qualified for his Captaincy. Later served as Company  
Commander until 1944 when he was made Lt.-Col.  
Also in 1944 was appointed District D. Officer M.D-12, Regina, Sask.  
Prior to the war. he was Superintendent in charge of the outdoor  
dental clinic at McGill Univ, <sup>Trust</sup> Resident House Surgeon  
Montreal General Hospital, and Provincial Dental Board  
Examiner.
