

JOHN ARCHER MacGOWAN, D. D. B.

Born in Tweed, Ontario, June 30, 1903, and attended Kent School and Oakwood Collegiate Institute in Toronto.

Graduated from the Royal College of Dental Surgeons, Toronto, in 1926, and practised dentistry in Sydenham, Ontario, later moving to Toronto.

World War II: Commissioned in the Canadian Dental Corps in 1940, and served at several of the stations in No. I Training Command before being posted to the Technical Training School at St. Thomas in 1942 with the rank of Major.
