



FRANK MARTIN, D.D.S. F.I.C.D.

Born in Cork, Ireland; ¹⁸⁹⁷ lived for a time near Belfast, and came to Canada at an early age: August 1908. Attended School at Dublin + Belfast.
 Matric in U. of T. + Khaki Univ., Ripon, England.
 Served an apprenticeship in the laboratory of Dr. Irvin Ante.
 Member Psi Omega Frat. 1923

Joined the Canadian Army Dental Corps in 1915; was at Valcartier, at Bramshott, England, and then accompanied the 4th Canadian Division to France attached to the 11th Field Ambulance. After about 1 1/2 years service in France, during which the Division moved up and down from Ypres to the Somme and back to Arras, and the taking of Vimy Ridge, he was recalled to England and detailed to the Jaw Injuries Division of the hospital at Sidcup, where he made splints and surgical prosthesis appliances for those with facial wounds.

Returned to Canada and entered the Dental College in 1919, and graduated in 1923.

Carried on a practice in Toronto for some years, and later became associated with Dr. Ante in the Medical Arts Bldg. in Toronto.

Served for several years on the Committees and the Executive of the Toronto Academy of Dentistry and was its President: 1934-1935.

Began his official connection with the Ontario Dental Association in 1936, serving

three years on the Dental Public Health Committee, and five years on the Board of Governors. Was its President in 1945-46

He is an Associate in Dentistry, Department of Prosthetics, Faculty of Dentistry, University of Toronto.

Elected President of the ^{Canadian} Oral Prophylactic Association in 1943. for 4 years.

He is an elder in Kew Beach United Church.

Member of Harmony Lodge and King Solomon Chapter in the Masonic Order.

At present (1948) is an Associate in Dentistry in the Clinical Dept. of the Faculty of Dentistry, University of Toronto, having joined the staff in 1936 in Prosthodontia

Elected a Fellow of the International College of Dentists, Sept., 1948

Since 1955 he is an Assistant Professor in the Prosthetic Dept.
