



H. J. Merkeley, M.D.S.

Born in Chesterville, near Ottawa, in 1886.

Attended local public schools, and the Collegiate at Morrisburg.

He was out of School for four years during which time he worked with location and construction surveys for the C.P.R. in Western Canada.

Returned East in 1907, took his degree at Toronto, and on graduation in 1911 established practise at Winnipeg.

He is lecturer in dentistry at the University of Manitoba, Medical Faculty of
