

OREN A. OLIVER, D.D.S., F.A.C.D., F.I.C.D.

Received his pre-dental education at Virginia Christian College and Virginia Polytechnic Institute. He attended Atlanta School of Medicine, now Emory College, Georgia, for two years and received his D.D.S. from Atlanta Dental College in 1909. He took post-graduate courses at Harvard University, Massachusetts General Hospital, Northwestern University and the Dewey School of Orthodontia.

He practiced dentistry in Virginia from 1909-1917, and since then has specialized in Orthodontics in Nashville, Tenn.

He has been active in dental and orthodontic societies for many years and is a member and past-president of the Nashville Fifth District Dental Society, The Tennessee State Dental Association, the Southern Society of Orthodontists, and the American Association of Orthodontists.

Served as a trustee of the American Dental Association from 1934-40. on a number of committees of the A.D.A. and in 1941 was its President-Elect and in 1942 its President.

He was the First Editor of the "Journal of the Tennessee State Dental Association." He is an associate editor of the "American Journal of Orthodontics and Oral Surgery" later the "American Journal of Orthodontics." He is co-author of the textbook "Labio-Lingual Technique" published in 1940, and has contributed to dental journals for twenty-five years. He has given papers and clinics before many dental organizations in America, and has appeared on dental programs in England, Holland and France.

He has as honorary membership in the Virginia State Dental Association, Alabama State Dental Association, New Jersey State Dental Society, Pacific Coast Society of Orthodontists, Southwestern Society of Orthodontists, European Odontological Society, Mexican Assoc. of Orthodontists, Mexican National Dental Federation, Australian Dental Association, Odontological Society of Costa Rica, Dental Society of Guatemala.

He presented a paper at the O.D.A. convention called "The Dentist's Responsibility to his Child Patients." He also conducted a clinic on the construction and manipulation of Labial and Lingual Arch Appliances.
