



ARTHUR REGINALD POAG, D.D.S.

Born in Hamilton, Ontario, September, 1895.

Matriculated from Central Collegiate, spent 8 months with the Steel Co. of Canada, and then worked for a druggist for two years. He entered the Royal College of Dental Surgeons in 1914.

In 1916, he enlisted in the Canadian Army Dental Corps, and went overseas as a private and sergeant. While in England, he managed and played with the C.A.D.C. basketball team that won the Bramshott Area Championship in 1917.

He returned to the Royal College of Dental Surgeons and graduated in 1919, during which year he won the Varsity 1st T in basketball.

After graduation, he associated himself for a time with Dr. E. M. Fulton, and then opened an office of his own.

He was President of the Hamilton Dental Academy, 1929-1930. A member of the Hamilton Kinsman Club, past Chairman of the Kinsman National Convention, past president of the Toronto and District Golfers, member of the Scottish Rite, the Thistle Curling Club, a member of Melrose United Church, Director and member of the Advisory Board of the A.D.N. & N.A. for 4 years, and a director of the Hamilton Senior Chamber of Commerce. He became President of the Ontario Dental Association, 1948-1949.
