

Dr. G. Arthur Roberts.

Born in Hamilton, Ontario in 1873.

Entered Royal College of Dental Surgeons, Toronto in 1893 and graduated from there in 1897.

Graduated from Philadelphia Dental College in 1898.

Shortly afterwards commenced general practice of dentistry in Toronto.

He decided to specialize in orthodontics and in 1904 gave up his general practice in order to enter Dr. Angle's School in St. Louis for six months post graduate work in this field.

He was the first in Ontario to specialize in orthodontics; and his practice became so large that he was joined by Dr. Guy Hulme with whom he was associate in practice until the time of his death. He was elected 2nd Vice President of the Toronto Dental Society in 1900 and 1st Vice President of that Society in May 1905.

From 1905 to the time of his death he was Secretary of the Ontario Dental Society. At the time of his death he was examiner in orthodontia at the R.C.D.S.

He died on April 14th, 1907.
