



OSWALD GEORGE SHEPHERD.

Born at Virgil, Ontario, on June 8, 1892.

After attending the public and high schools of North Bay, he completed his preparatory education at Trinity College School, Port Hope.

He enlisted in 1915 & went overseas with the 159th Algonguin Battalion. Overseas, he transferred to the Canadian Machine Gun Corps.

After returning to Canada, he graduated from the Royal College of Dental Surgeons in 1923 and began practise at Hamilton. After 10 years he moved to Sudbury.

In 1940, he enlisted as a dirvt. in the Veteran's Guard of Canada & then transferred to the C.D.C. 8 months later, posted to Camp Borden as Captain. He was appointed Camp Dental Officer in July, 1942, & in Sept. 1942 he became Major. In Nov. 1944 he became Lt.-Col. of No. 29 Co'y.
