

RALPH FREDERICK SOMMER. D.D.S., M.S., F.A.A.O.R.

Graduated from the University of Michigan School of Dentistry at Ann Arbor, in 1924.

In 1934 he was Assistant Professor of Operative Dentistry, Ann Arbor, and at present is professor of Dentistry and Head of Departments of Endodontia and Radiology, School of Dentistry University of Michigan.
