



ALEXANDER BRUCE SUTHERLAND, D.D.S., D.D.PH.

Born in Bradford, Ontario, and attended public and High Schools there. He graduated from the Faculty of Dentistry, University of Toronto in 1927.

Was in practice from 1927 until 1940 when he enlisted in the Canadian Dental Corps. He volunteered for the Pacific but was denied this service on account of the course of events there. He became a Captain in 1940, and was made a Major overseas. He later volunteered his services to UNRA as a dental officer and gave his services in Europe, spending much time in Poland.

He received his Diploma in Dental Public Health from the School of Hygiene, University of Toronto in, 1948, and in the fall of the same year accepted an appointment to the Sudbury Dept. of Health as Director of Dental Survey and Education in the Public Health Department.
