Educator, Theologian and authority on affairs in the Near East.

Born in Port Dover in 1882.

Educated at the Public and High Schools of the town and at Simcoe High.
Attended University of Toronto, Knox College and University of Berlin.

1907-10 Assistant Minister of Victoria Presbyterian Church, West Toronto.

1910 -Went to Vancouver as Professor of the Old Testament Languages and Literature. at Westminster Hall.

1914 Came to the University of Toronto as Professor of Semitic Languages.

1929-30 Annual Professor at the American School of Oriental Research in Jerusalem.

1931 Held the Chancellor's lectureship at Queen's University.

1932 Visiting Professorship at New York Union Theological Seminary.

1945 Appointed Principal of University College, University of Toronto, to succeed President-elect Sydney Smith.

Canadian Representative on a committee engaged in a new translation of the Bible.

Engaged at the present moment in writing a book on Academic study.
