

JOHN ROBERT THOMPSON. D.D.S., M.S.D., M.S.

Graduated from Northwestern University Dental School in 1934.

Became a member of the Illinois State Dental Society in 1935.

He received his degree of M.S.D. in orthodontia from the Northwestern University in 1937, and his M.S. in orthodontia from the University of Illinois in 1940.

He was Associate Professor of Oral Anatomy and Comparative Odontology at the University of Illinois College of Dentistry, and is now Associate Professor of Orthodontics at Northwestern University, and Director of the Department of Orthodontia.

He held a Carnegie Fellowship for one year and was on the Program for the Illinois State Dental Society in 1942.

He is a member of the American Association of Orthodontists, the Central Association of Orthodontists, and is affiliated with the Edward H. Angle Society of Orthodontia, and the Chicago Association of Orthodontists.

Formerly with the University of Illinois as Research Associate of the Department of Orthodontia and Director of the Department of Oral Anatomy.

In 1949, he was made Director of of the new Cleft Palate Institute of Northwestern University (formed by the three schools of dentistry, medicine and speech.)

In 1948, he presented post-graduate courses in Sweden, Denmark and Norway.

In 1950, he was made an Honorary Fellow in the Academy of Denture Prosthesis, and was a Clinician at the C.D.A. Convention.
