

ROBERT LAWRENCE TWIBLE

Born in Toronto March 23, 1907.

He attended Parkdale Collegiate, and the Faculty of Dentistry, University of Toronto, from which he received his D. D. S. in 1931, and his B. Sc.D. in 1935.

In his final University year, he was on the Executive Committee of the Dramatics Society. He was also interested in music.

He Joined the Staff in 1937, and was Granted Leave of Absence in 1941 to Enlist in the Royal Canadian Dental Corps. He was Re-instated in 1945.

He was Appointed Head of the Department of Prosthodontics and was Promoted to the Rank of Professor in 1960.

He was Made a Fellow of the American College of Dentists in 1957, and he is a Charter Fellow of the Royal College of Dentists of Canada.
