



HAROLD LINCOLN WINDRIM, D.D.S., D.D.P.H.

Born in London, Ontario, in 1890.

Received his early education at Lorne Ave. School and Central Collegiate Institute in London, Ontario. He came to the Royal College of Dental Surgeons in 1918 and graduated in 1921.

He has been in public service since 1924 as public School Dental Officer and Senior Dental Officer of the London Board of Education Staff.
